



Keel Side table RODOLFO DORDONI

DESCRIPTION

The Keel coffee table takes its name from the English word for the steel structure along the base of a boat, due to its blade supports that mimic the shape, and three-dimensionally characterize the tops. The top can be round, square or rectangular, and it features an original architecture thanks to the 45° angle at which the edge is cut, chiseled towards the bottom.

- Top: Contoured Dedalus marble (only for Ø 47" and Ø 55" and the 47" x 47" and 71"L x 43"W tops) in matt lacquered eucalyptus or with glossy lacquered finish in the colours Army Green, Moka, Cappuccino and Ice
- Legs: Brandy-colored polished aluminum
