## DESCRIPTION

The Materic table, designed by Piero Lissoni, is a sculptural object where the absolute simplicity of design is juxtaposed to the sophistication of materials and workmanships. Materic features a round and tapered table top, laying on a turned truncated cone as a base. The top comes in marble, available in fine nuances ranging from verde ramaggiato to the more traditional white Carrara marble. The table top can also feature a rotating tray in the middle. The base is made up of 12 sandblasted natural ash, black stained or dark brown stained solid ash boards that are turned and connected to one another with finger joints so as to obtain a perfect truncated cone with a distinct wood grain.

- Rotating central disc
